ARIZONA ECONOMY

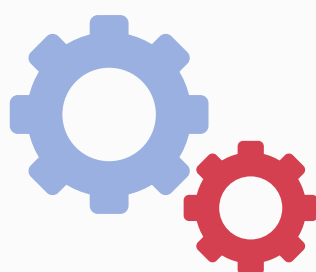
The economy of Arizona employs 3.06M people. The largest industries in Arizona are Restaurants & Food Services (216,856 people), Construction (193,494 people), and Elementary & secondary schools (181,575 people), and the highest paying industries are Furniture & home furnishing merchant wholesalers (\$141,210), Labor unions (\$122,857), and Construction, & mining & oil & gas field machinery manufacturing (\$121,870).

EMPLOYMENT BY OCCUPATIONS

The most common job groups, by number of people living in Arizona, are Customer service representatives (96,319 people), Other managers (71,644 people), and Elementary & middle school teachers (66,352 people).

EMPLOYMENT BY INDUSTRIES

The most common employment sectors for those who live in Arizona, are Restaurants & Food Services (216,856 people), Construction (193,494 people), and Elementary & secondary schools (181,575 people).

Compared to other states, Arizona has an unusually high number of Metal ore mining (12.2 times higher than expected), Aerospace products & parts manufacturing (4.75 times), and Not specified utilities (2.74 times) industries.
